Things You Can Do While Looking for a Job

Temp Work – One way to gain experience, build contacts and make money while seeking a job is to do temp work. There are a variety of temporary employment agencies including large national chains (e.g., Winston, Kelly), specialty or small boutique firms, those who specialize in a particular field (e.g., Accountemps, Update Legal) as well as online listings (Nettemps.com, Monster.com)

Volunteer – Volunteering is a great way to stay busy and network with new people. Through this type of experience you can learn about job leads, gain experiential knowledge, hone skills, and hopefully make some new friends while helping your community!

Informational Interviews – An information interview is a meeting with someone in your chosen field during which you ask for advice rather than a job. They are a great way to learn more about your field, an organization, trends, and the job market in your chosen area. It also provides you with the ability to build a network of contacts within your field.
