### Parking:

The conference will be held in Stocking Hall at 411 Tower Road, Ithaca, NY 14853 (at the corner of Tower Road & Wing Drive). The closest parking option to Stocking Hall is the Peterson Lot (Lot 4122), across from the building on Tower Road (pay by cash at the meter or via the ParkMobile app). Because of its location by the Dairy Bar and Botanic Gardens, this lot can fill up early; the best alternative option is Lot 4108 (two blocks away on Campus Road; pay by ParkMobile only). ### Hotel:

A conference block rate of \$169/night is available at the Homewood Suites near the Ithaca airport (rate includes free Wi-Fi, daily breakfast, and parking). Rooms can be booked directly at [THIS LINK](#).

The Statler Hotel (<https://statlerhotel.cornell.edu/>) is a 10-minute walk from Stocking Hall; please note that the hotel frequently has limited availability, and advance booking is strongly recommended. We suggest the Canopy by Hilton, Marriott Downtown, or Hilton Garden Inn (all located on or near the Ithaca Commons, a 10-minute drive from campus in the Ithaca Downtown area) as good alternatives.
