The CALS Kathy Berggren Diversity and Inclusion Award recognizes members of the CALS faculty or academic staff who have made a significant contribution to enhancing a positive climate for multicultural diversity within their teaching, research and/or extension program.

Examples in teaching & advising include:

- Acting as mentor for underrepresented students (as an advisor or instructor for undergraduate students or teaching assistants)
- Serving as a role model by socially interacting with students (attends student activities and cultural events, invites to dinner, etc.).
- Incorporating diversity issues within course curriculum.

Examples in research include:

- Acting as mentor for underrepresented students (as an advisor or instructor for graduate students or teaching assistants)
- Helping students find research opportunities or working with students in a research setting
- Promoting professional development in the area of research (i.e. grant writing, conference presentations, publications, etc.)

Examples in outreach include:

- Managing outreach programs benefit minority populations.
 - Recruiting and promoting promising minority candidates for employment or advancement
 - Developing a county, statewide or regional program that has successfully raised awareness about issues of diversity and fostered action to address them.
